This year she has a pair of film in which she stars, so try and catch her at either: *The Voices* (with Ryan Reynolds and Anna Kendrick) at Ryerson Theatre 9:00pm on Thursday, September 11th, which is a Premium screening. Or *Gemma Bovary* at Wintergarden Theatre on Saturday, September 6th at 1:45pm, which is not.

Jason Bateman

Jason Bateman is back once again, having attended the festival several times in the past, including last year with his directorial debut. This year he is part of the ensemble cast of the film *This Is Where I Leave You*. It will be having its premiere as a Gala screening at Roy Thomson Hall on Sunday, September 7th at 6:30PM. Expect to see him and many other members of the cast walk the red carpet for this one.

Daniel Brühl

Daniel was at the festival for last year's premiere of *Rush* and returns this year with his latest film *The Face of an Angel*. It will be making its debut Saturday, September 6th at 8:00PM at the Winter Garden Theatre so expect to see him walk the carpet there.

Kevin Costner

Mr. Costner is in the Gala film *Bland and White* which will have its World Premiere at Roy Thomson Hall on Saturday,

September 6th at 3:00PM. Expect to see him walk the carpet along with fellow cast members Octavia Spencer and Anthony Mackie.

Benedict Cumberbatch

Always a festival favourite, with the 2013 Festival being nicknamed "The Year of the Cumberbatch", Benedict will return this year with the much-hyped film *The Imitation Game*. Screening at the Princess of Wales Theatre on Tuesday September 9th at 6:00PM, expect to see him walking the red carpet with fellow cast member Keira Knightley.

Robert Downey Jr.

Sure to be one of the biggest draws of the festival, Robert stars in this year's Opening Night Film *The Judge*. There will be two simultaneous screenings of the film on the opening night, one at Roy Thomson Hall for industry and the press, and just down the street at the Princess of Wales Theatre. Historically, the second screening of it (previously at the Elgin) will be for the fans only. This red carpet will not have media so the actors are there to interact with the crowds. Expect this one to have a lot of energy. Both screenings will happen on Thursday, September 4th. The one for the fans at the Princess of Wales Theatre starts at 6:30PM and the one at Roy Thomson Hall will start at 8:00PM. Expect Downey Jr. to walk the carpet at both events with fellow cast member Robert Duvall.

Adam Driver

Adam will be one of the hardest working actors at the festival, with three films. Expect to see him on the red carpet as part of the ensemble cast of *This Is Where I Leave You* which screens at Roy Thomson Hall on Sunday, September 7th at 6:30PM. Expect to also find him at the premiere screening of the film *While We're Young* which occurs on Saturday, September 6th at 7:00PM at the Princess of Wales Theatre, and he will possibly showing up to the first or second screenings of the film *Hungry Hearts* which screens Sunday, September 7th at 9:15PM at the TIFF Bell Lightbox and Tuesday, September 9th at 3:30PM at the Scotiabank Theatre. He may have conflicting schedules on Sunday the 9th so it is unclear if he will be attending both on that night but the odds are pretty good he will be.

Robert Duvall

Robert Duvall will likely be found on the red carpets for both screenings of the *The Judge* with Robert Downey Jr. The film screens at 6:30PM at the Princess of Wales Theatre and 8:00PM at Roy Thomson Hall on Thursday, September 4th. Robert will also be attending a Mavericks event on Friday, September 5th at 1:00PM at the TIFF Bell Lightbox.

Ansel Elgort

A very popular actor right now, having starred in recent hit films *Divergent* and *The Fault in our Stars*, expect to find Elgort on the red carpet at the World Premiere of Jason Reitman's new film *Men, Women & Children*, along with co-stars Adam Sandler, Rosemarie DeWitt, Jennifer Garner, and potentially J.K. Simmons. The film screens Saturday, September 6th at 6:00PM at the Ryerson Theatre.

Chris Evans

Chris will be attending the festival this year with his directorial debut *Before We Go*. He both directs and stars in this film. Expect to find him with co-star Alice Eve at the first screening of the film Friday, September 12th at 6:30PM at the Princess of Wales Theatre. Since he is the director of the film and not just acting in it, it's possible that he will also be in attendance of at least the second screening of the film the next day, Saturday, September 13th at 12:15PM at The Bloor Hot Docs Cinema.

Garner stars in *Men, Women & Children* and can be expected to arrive at the World Premiere screening of the film on

Saturday, September 6th at 6:00PM at the Ryerson Theatre with co-stars Ansel Elgort, Adam Sandler, Rosemarie DeWitt, and possibly J.K. Simmons.

Richard Gere

Richard Gere can be found walking the red carpet at the premiere of his latest film *Time out of Mind* on Sunday, September 7th at 6:15PM at the Elgin Theatre. He will also be in attendance at a Mavericks event on Saturday, September 6th at 8:00PM at the Glenn Gould Theatre at the CBC building.

Jake Gyllenhaal

Jake continues his streak of taking roles in daring and challenging projects with this year's film *Nightcrawler*. Expect to see him and fellow cast members Bill Pullman and Rene Russo on the red carpet at the World Premiere screening taking place Friday, September 5th at 9:00PM at the Princess of Wales Theatre.

Ethan Hawke

Ethan Hawke will be pulling double duty at this year's Festival with an acting role in *Good Kill* and as director of the documentary *Seymour: An Introduction*. Expect to find him on the red carpet at the Ryerson Theatre on Tuesday, September 9th for the 9:00PM screening of *Good Kill* and at the first screening of his documentary on Wednesday, September 10th at 7:00PM at the TIFF Bell Lightbox. Since he is the director of that film, he may also attend the other 2 screenings of his film on Thursday, September 11th, and Saturday, September 13th.

Liam & Luke Hemsworth

The youngest and eldest Hemsworth brothers each have a film screening at this year's festival. Middle brother Chris was at the festival last year with the Gala film *Rush*. While neither of them is listed on the Official Guest List as attending this year, it is possible that they may still show, unannounced guests have surprised the fans before. Luke's film *Kill Me Three Times* screens for the first time Saturday, September 6th at 9:00PM at the Scotiabank Theatre. Co-star Simon Pegg is scheduled to appear in town so if Luke doesn't show, Simon will likely be there. Liam stars this year in the film *Cut Bank*, which screens Wednesday, September 10th at 5:00PM at the Scotiabank Theatre. If he does unexpectedly show up, expect it to be at that one. None of the other cast members of this film are expected to attend this year so it may be a long shot.

Dustin Hoffman

Dustin Hoffman is another actor with 2 films at the festival, with the Gala presentation of *Boychoir* and the film *The Cobbler* in the Special Presentations programme. Expect to find him on the red carpet at Roy Thomson Hall for the Gala of *Boychoir* on Friday, September 5th at 6:30PM. His other film, *The Cobbler*, is also having a premium red carpet screening but it's on Thursday, September 11 at 9:00PM at the Elgin Theatre. It's almost a week later so it's tough to say whether or not he will stick around for both. If he does attend the screening of *The Cobbler*, expect to see him on the red carpet with co-star Adam Sandler.

Diane Keaton

Diane will be expected to walk the red carpet with co-star Morgan Freeman at the Gala presentation of *Ruth & Alex*. The film screens at Roy Thomson Hall on Friday, September 5th at 9:30PM.

Anna Kendrick

Another actor with 2 films at this year's festival, Anna is here with *Cake*, co-starring with Jennifer Aniston, and *The Last Five Years*. Expect to find her at the first screening of *The Last Five Years* on Sunday, September 7th at 8:30PM at the Ryerson Theatre and at the premiere screening of *Cake* at the Elgin Theatre on Monday, September 8th at 2:30PM.

Expect to find him on the red carpet at Roy Thomson Hall for the Gala screening of the film on Friday, September 12th at 9:30PM. Co-stars Christopher Plummer, Tye Sheridan, and Abigail Spencer are also scheduled to attend.

Denzel Washington

Denzel Washington once again partners up with director Antoine Fuqua (last at the Festival together with *Training Day*) for the film *The Equalizer*. Expect to find him on the red carpet at the Gala screening of the film at Roy Thomson Hall on Sunday, September 7th at 9:30PM. Co-star Chloë Grace Moretz will also likely be attending.

Kristen Wiig

Kristen Wiig takes a dramatic turn with her latest film *Welcome to Me*. Expect to find her at the first screening which happens Friday, September 5th at 2:45PM at the Princess of Wales Theatre.

Kate Winslet

Kate stars in this year's Closing Night Film *A Little Chaos*, so expect to find her at the end of the Festival. Much like the Opening Night Film, this one will have two premium red carpet screenings back-to-back. Expect to see Winslet and director Alan Rickman walk the red carpet at both events.
